Cooking food on a wood burning fire in a cookstove gives food a natural taste. The baking/roasting compartment can reach temperatures up to 500°F. The thermometer enables cooking food to perfection. The Heckla comes with an oven rack, a solid tray rack, and a baking stone. Special spring handles enable ease of use and provide a compact look. There is a drawer for storage underneath.

Quality constructed with cooking in mind, the body is made of high-grade steel in a gray steel finish. The cladding is available in a variety of tile colors (shown on the opposite page in burnt orange tile and at top right in white tile), gray steel, sandstone, or natural stone (all shown at right). Top vent only.

Tested to Washington State fireplace environmental standards, and approved to UL 1482 standards in the United States and ULC S627 in Canada, the Heckla is highly efficient (78%) and clean-burning.
